IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TOURIST BUSES HEADED TO MARCHÉ VERT NOËL

Short stop (passenger loading/unloading)

Tourist buses transporting visitors to Marché Vert Noël may use, exclusively for passenger loading and unloading, five designated parking spaces in the East area of the parking lot on via Mazzini (except on Tuesdays and on December 24th and 31st due to the presence of the city market). The stop is limited to 30 minutes, and the starting time must be indicated using the methods specified by the Highway Code, such as the parking disc.

How to get there

The easiest way to reach the passenger loading/unloading area in via Mazzini is to approach it from the East, following via Clavalité, via Caduti del Lavoro, and via Garibaldi.

Note: This route must also be taken when exiting the parking lot.

Extended stay

For extended stays, buses can use the parking lot at the piezometric tower square, located in the South-East area of Aosta, on the outskirts of the city, and granted for this occasion by the company VdA Structure.

How to get there

To reach the piezometric tower square more easily, tourist buses coming from East (Turin, Milan) and from North (Switzerland) can, after unloading passengers on via Mazzini, proceed West along via Carrel (towards the train station), continue on via Carducci and then on viale Partigiani, take the third exit at the roundabout heading downhill towards the railway bridge below, then turn left after passing under the bridge and continue along via Paravera, turn right at the roundabout towards via I Maggio, and continue along via Lavoratori Vittime del Col du Mont until reaching the parking lot. Those coming from the West (France) can take via Piccolo San Bernardo and then turn right onto via Grand'Eyvia just before the roundabout, and at the next roundabout, continue on via Garin and then turn left onto via Generale Dalla Chiesa.

"Consolata" pay parking lot

For extended stays, tourist buses traveling along SS26 in the section of via Roma can use the "Consolata" pay parking located on viale Chabod (300 meters from piazza Arco d'Augusto).
